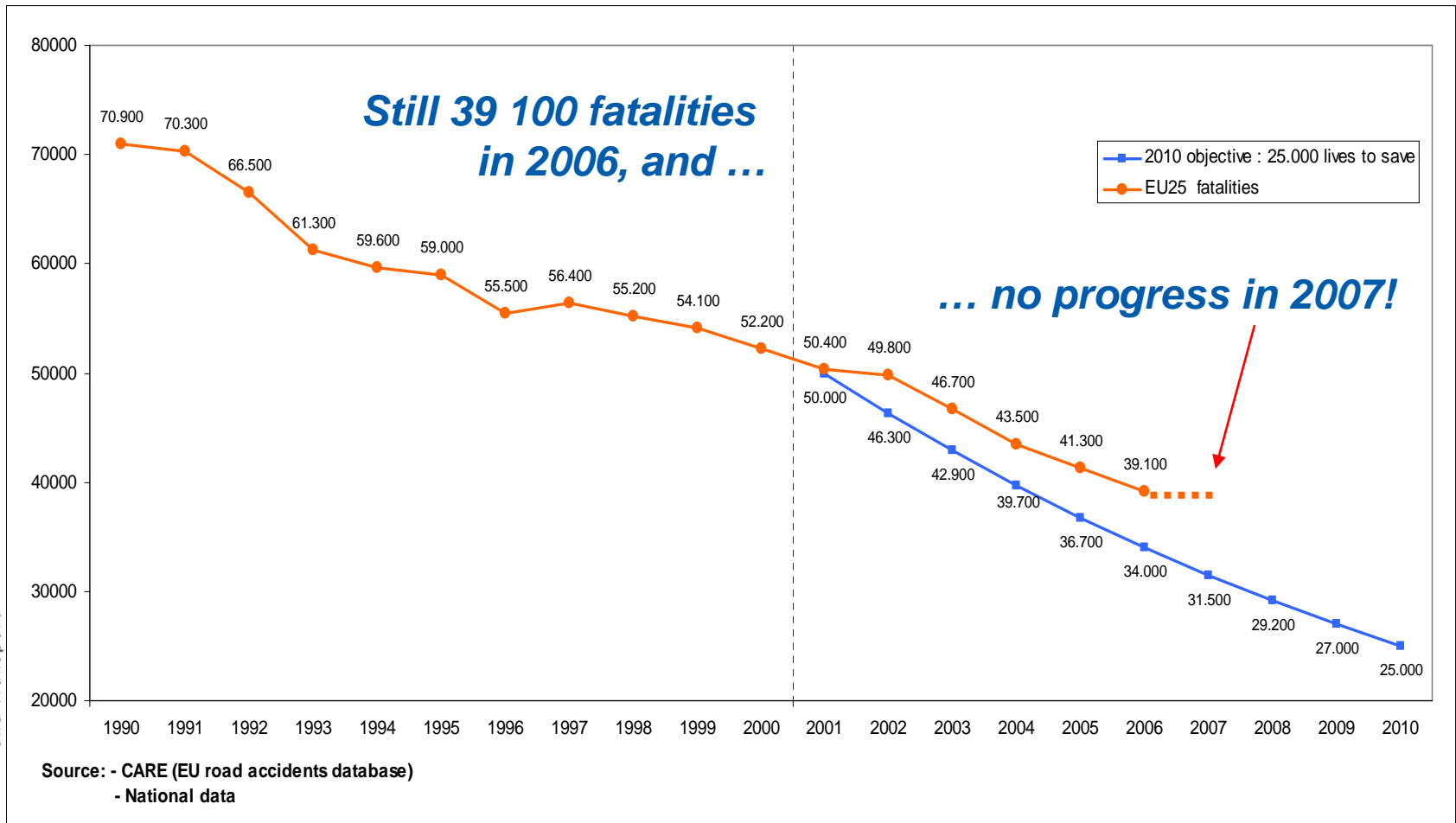

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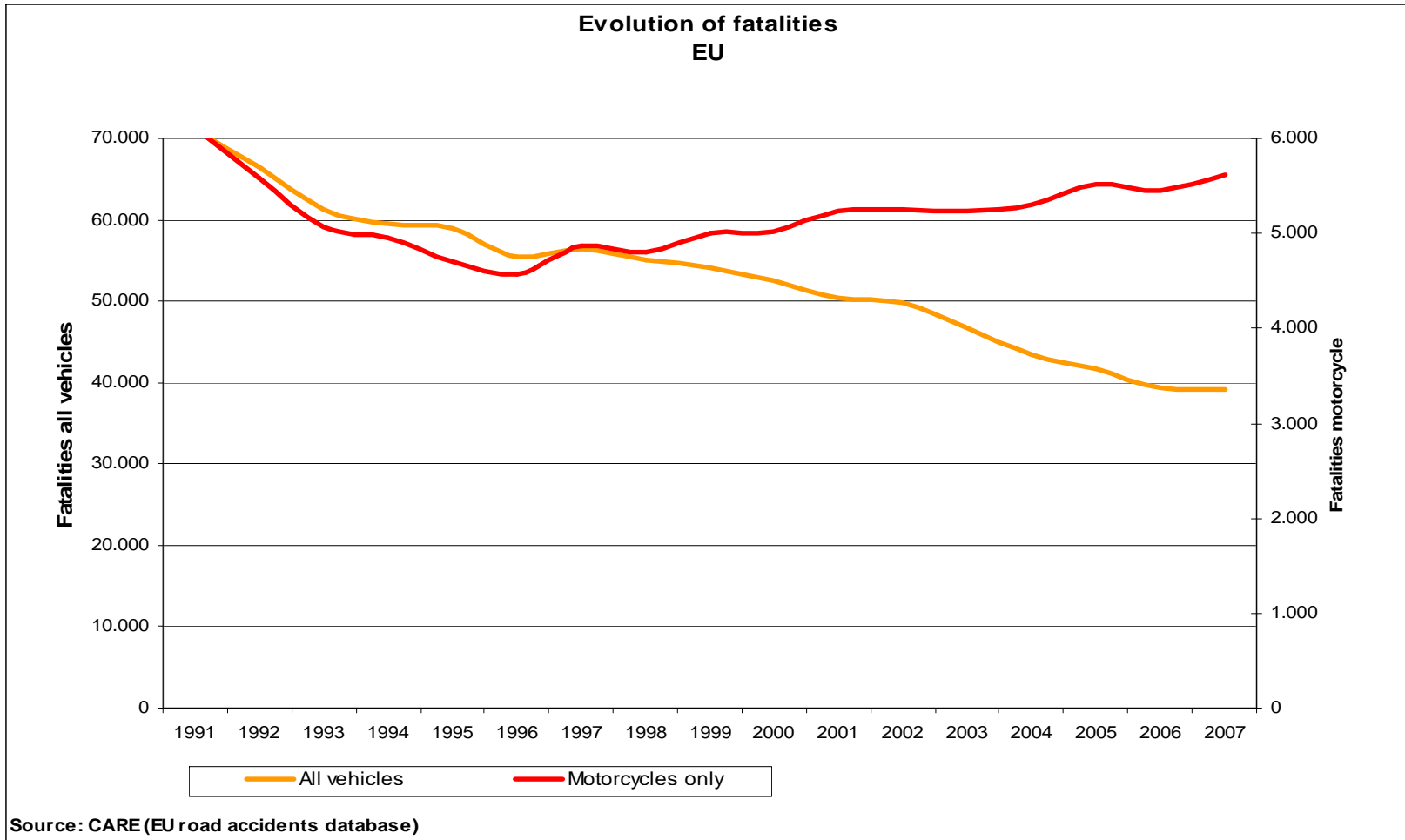
EU Road Safety - the “-50%” Objective

- *Halving the number of victims by 2010: saving 25 000 lives/year*
- *A shared responsibility*
 - » *Action by all stakeholders is needed: EU, national governments, local authorities, industry, transport companies...ALL USERS !!!*

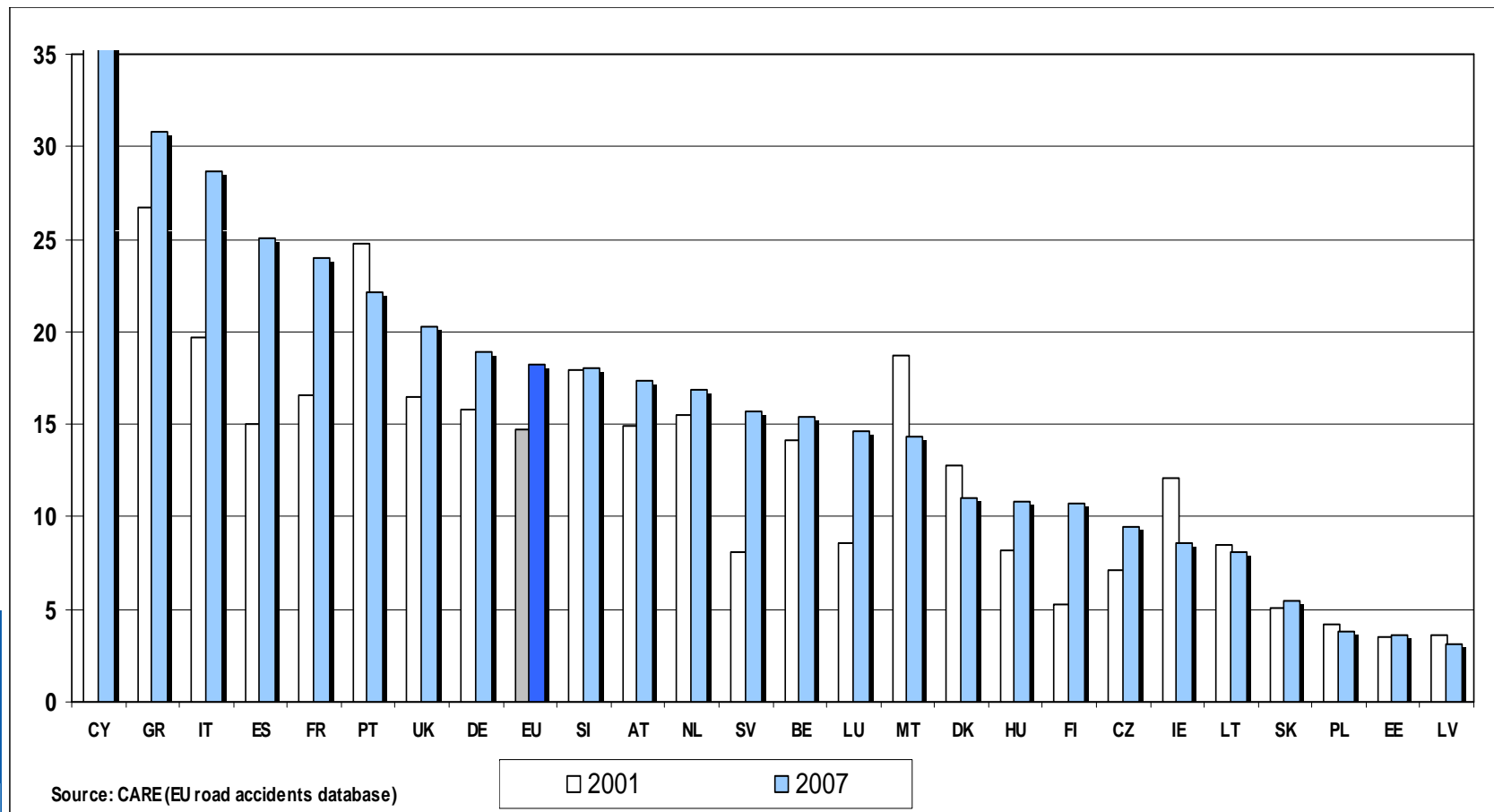
Fatalities – evolution 1990-2010

From 110 models...

... to a single model

Better harmonisation of categories: Progressive access to the powered-2 wheels

- ***MOPEDS (Article 4.2)***
 - ***New category AM (max. 50 cm³ & 45 Km/h): age 16, theory test***
- ***MOPEDS (Articles 4.6 & 7.1.b)***
 - ***Minimum age may be lowered to 14 or raised up to 18***
 - ***A test of skills and behaviour may be required by Member States***

Better harmonisation of categories: Progressive access to the powered-2 wheels

- **MOTORCYCLES (Article 4.3 & 7.1.c)**
 - **A1 (max. 125 cm³, 11 kW & 0.1 kW/kg), age 16**
 - **New A2 (max. 35 kW & 0.2 kW/kg), age 18**
 - **after 2 years experience A1: training, or practical test (annex VI*)**
 - **otherwise (direct access): theory & practical tests (annex II*)**
- **A (all motorcycles)**
 - **after 2 years experience A2, age 20: training, or practical test (annex VI*)**
 - **otherwise option of direct access, age 24: theory & practical tests (annexe II*)**

* annexes of Directive 2006/126/EC of 20 December 2006 (OJEU L403/18)

Access to the powered-2 wheels

- **MOTORCYCLES (Article 4.6)**
 - » **Category A 1: minimum age may be raised up to 17 or 18 years old, if there is a two years difference between the minimum ages for each category**
 - » **Example: if category A 1 is issued at 17 years old in a MS, minimum age for category A 2 would be 19 and for category A, 21**

Access to the powered-3 wheels

- *Motor tricycles*

- » *Category AM: motor tricycles (max. 50 cm³ & 45 Km/h)*

- » *Category A 1: motor tricycles with a power not exceeding 15 kW*

- » *Category A: motor tricycles with a power exceeding 15 kW (21 y.)*
